Statement Regarding Nature of Urgent Public Necessity: The untimely and unexpected death of Mr. Art Pierard, Councilmember – Place 6, has created a vacancy on the Midlothian City Council which, in accordance with Texas Constitution art. XI, sec. 11, must be filled by special election held within 120 days after the date the vacancy occurred. In order to fill the vacancy by special election to be held on the next uniform election date allowed under the Texas Election Code, May 2, 2020, and to comply with other applicable deadlines under the Texas Election Code, the Midlothian City Council must call a special election to fill Mr. Pierard’s unexpired term on or before February 22, 2020.
